In this collection the city is considered as a theatrical stage that witnessed many narrations from his actors (people) during the day but night makes a different scene of it and the city scene becomes empty of actors this time. Indeed, at night, a new screen of this play comes on the stage and shows the spectator the underlying layer of this permanent and roaring theater. For this purpose, the city is likened to an imaginary theater by taking photo from Tehran at night and situating elements like city light-bulbs which remind theater stage projectors.
